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

- Pre-Covid workflow for injections
 - CMA Injection clinic for solid tumor patients
 - RNs administered injections for hematologic malignancy patients
 - All patients receive a pre-appt screening call the evening prior
 - Ambulatory Clinical Evaluation (ACE) program clears patient
 - Drugs prepared in advance
- •Patients required in-clinic nurse visits for central line flushing and maintenance
- Patients required a lab appt for all blood draws
- Decreased wait times
- High patient satisfaction

COVID-19 Pandemic - March 2020

- Majority of provider appointments via telemedicine
- Patients were fearful of coming into cancer centers
- Patients were delaying care
- Oncology command center formed
- Testing tents were initiated for COVID-19
- Curbside clinic planning and implementation started
